**PROCEDURE FOR TEACHERS TO FOLLOW IN THE EVENT OF THE NEED TO  
SEPARATE A CHILD WITH AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR**

1. A teacher or other adult who witnesses aggressive behavior should immediately separate the perpetrator from the victim and provide assistance to the victim.
2. The separation of the perpetrator is intended to serve, in addition to interrupting the behavior, to provide conditions for the aggressive child to calm down.
3. Separation can take place in the following ways depending on the scale of the incident:
  - the teacher asks the aggressively behaving child to take a place at a designated point in the room (courtyard corridor). The place must be away from the victim's location, but at the same time directly supervised by the teacher;
  - the teacher asks for help from another teacher or notifies the preschool's secretary's office / preschool director by telephone that support in the form of isolating the perpetrator is needed. The preschool director or his/her designee (another teacher, psychologist) picks up the child from the scene of the incident and escorts him/her to the director's office or psychologist's office. The child is supervised at all times by an adult who helps him/her to control his/her emotions;
  - the preschool director shall call the parents of the aggressive child to pick up the child from the preschool and provide care at home;
  - In extreme situations, the teacher, in consultation with the preschool director, notifies the relevant services (Police, Ambulance Service) and the child's parents.
