



**PROCEDURE FOR TEACHERS ON HOW TO RESPOND TO DIFFICULT
BEHAVIOR OF A CHILD.
COVERS IMMEDIATE AND LONG-TERM ACTIONS.**

1. In relation to a child causing educational problems, the teacher shall undertake the following actions aiming at elimination of difficulties and solving the child's problems:
 - in cooperation with the educationalist and psychologist, carries out a diagnosis of the child's educational, emotional and family problems and plans the course of action,
 - informs the parents (legal guardians) of the child about the existing difficulties and familiarize them with actions to be taken in relation to the child in the preschool, at the same time obliging the parents to cooperate in this respect,
 - in the case of persisting difficulties with the child, the teacher initiates a meeting with members of the team of teachers of the International Preschool of Gdansk in order to obtain help and support in overcoming educational problems,
 - after analysis of the situation, the caregiver may suggest psychological or psychiatric examination, informing the parent of the importance of the opinion in further education of the child,
 - At a meeting of the Council of Teachers, the teacher familiarizes the teaching staff in detail with the situation, presents the actions taken so far and the facts of the day.
 - The Council of Teachers decides on further courses of action for the child.

2. In the case of a child whose behavior does not improve despite measures taken, the teacher/psychologist cooperating with the preschool in consultation with the preschool director shall notify the Family Court.
